SOFTWARE TIP

Too Much Open?


If you accumulate a lot of open documents and programs on your screen, here is a lovely trick to minimise all except the one you are working on.

Click & Shake

Click the title bar of the window you want to remain open to select it. Holding your mouse down, move the window back and forth quickly -- shaking it. After a few quick shakes, you're left with one.

Or

If you want everything to minimise in Windows, you can hit the small vertical bar on the bottom right-hand side of the screen (see image below).
